COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

4. For any concerns or complaints, you can write directly to info@impact-now.org. Your complaint will be dealt with confidentially. You will receive within one week a confirmation of receipt and an official response to the complaint within a 4-week period. If not satisfied, the Tilburg University Committee will serve as an independent third party (summerschool@maastrichtuniversity.nl). Their ruling will be final for all parties concerned. All complains filed will be kept for a minimum of 1 year and a maximum of 2 years.
